## ICP AND REHAB DIRECTIVES



### **ICP DIRECTIVES:**

**In order to better protect the safety and wellness of our firefighters and members of cooperating agencies, every effort shall be made to limit ICP access only to personnel essential to the operation.**

**Consider the use of FireLine tape to limit access and to control entry points.**



**If possible, position vehicles so that a single access control point can be maintained. The work area shall be delineated by using FireLine tape.**

**A member of the ICP support team can be assigned to manage the Controlled Access Point. This will ensure that all non-essential personnel remain outside of the ICP.**



**Face masks shall be worn at all times while in the ICP. Ensure that all personnel entering the ICP are given a simple face mask.**

**Make every attempt to clean and disinfect items within the ICP, especially if they are shared.**







**Avoid the sharing of mobile radios if possible**

**REHAB DIRECTIVES:**

**Firefighters entering rehab should pass through an access control point to ensure compliance and documentation. Do not place water and electrolyte fluid at or near the entrance.**

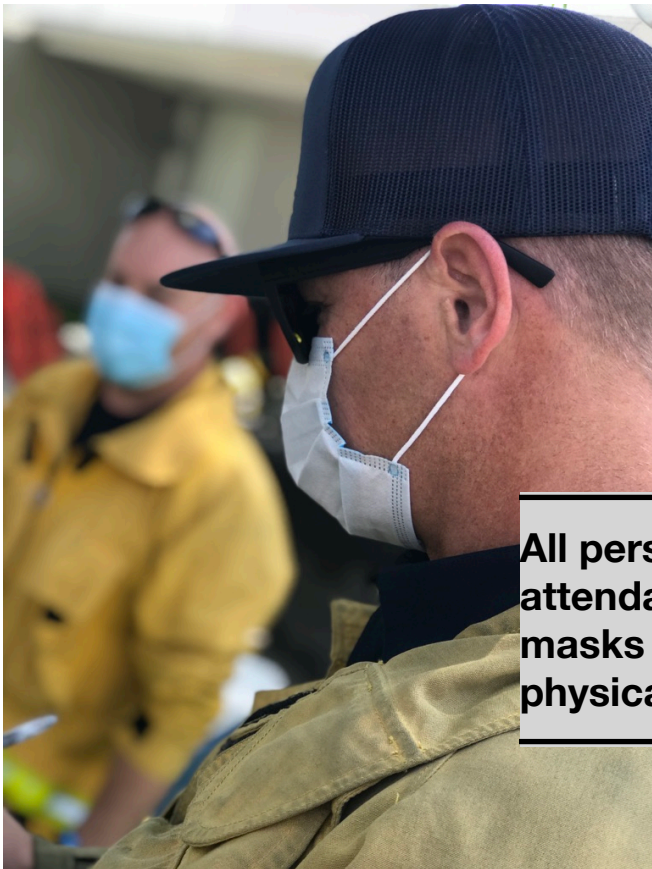
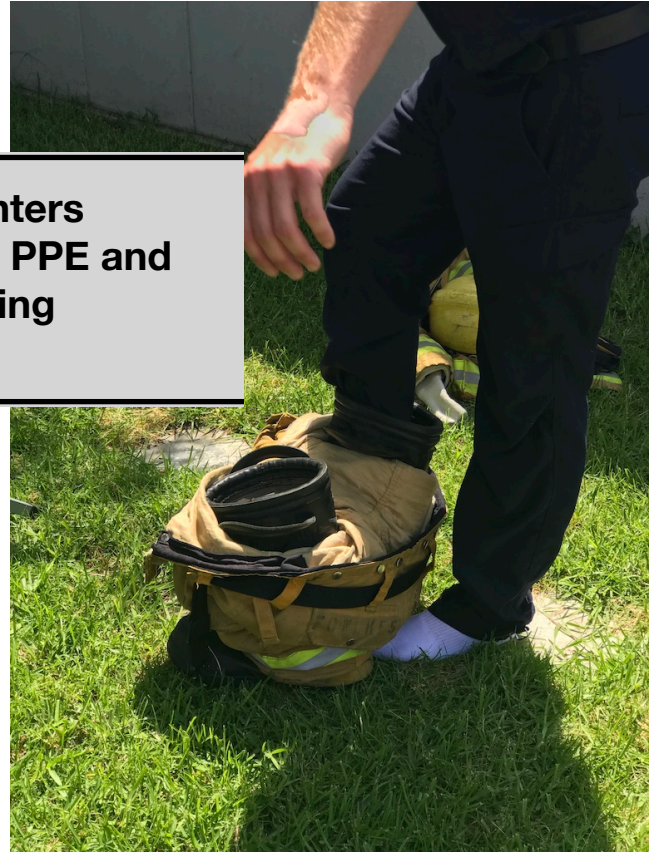


**Place EPA-approved hand sanitizer at the entrance.**





**Make sure that all firefighters entering Rehab doff their PPE and are checked-in by attending personnel.**



**All personnel assigned to Rehab as attendants shall wear simple face masks at all times to ensure proper physical distancing.**

**Personnel shall cleanse hands and forearms with EPA-approved hand wipes prior to immersion into ice bath.**





**Firefighters going through Rehab shall be placed a minimum of 6 feet apart and shall NOT wear facemasks.**

**Wipe chairs with Spirit or other EPA-approved disinfectant after each use.**
